Remote Learning - Data

We are able to apply for increases to data allowances on mobile devices. School can request mobile data increases for children who

- * Do not have fixed broadband at home.
- * Can not afford additional data for devices.
- * Are experiencing disruption to their face to face education.

Access to mobile data is available on the following networks.

- * Three
- * Smarty
- * Virgin mobile
- * EE
- * Tesco mobile
- * Sky mobile

Other providers may join the scheme at a later date.

If this is not an option, school may be able to request a 4G wireless router.
