Oz



They have been learning how to use persuasive techniques to create adverts and brochures to persuade others to visit Thornton-Cleveleys, considering the different layouts and language needed and the target audience. In Maths we have been studying the Census 21 and have enjoyed counting our steps to school, star jumps, squats and high knees and recording these in a range of graphs and charts. We have also been investigating Earthquakes, where they are most likely to occur and why, and then plotting the most recent ones on a map. We have also learned lots of new vocabulary related to this topic and why some earthquakes cause more damage than others. We have continued to enjoy learning to play the Ukelele and developing our growth mindset.
